Good Samaritan Health Center Medical Internship Position

The Good Samaritan Health Center Medical Internship Program is designed for individuals pursuing a career as a health care provider. The program offers the opportunity to gain experience in the health care field, train as a medical assistant, and engage in direct patient care. During this unpaid internship, interns will work along side staff LPNs, medical assistants and health care providers to deliver high quality primary and limited specialty care to underserved communities throughout the Atlanta Metro Region. The internship includes both direct patient care tasks and administrative assistance needed to maintain clinic flow and follow up.

Requirements:

- Minimum weekly commitment of one day per week
- Minimum 6 month commitment to internship program
- Two week on-site training (schedule can be negotiated individually)
- Adherence to Good Samaritan Health Center policy and procedures

- Training as a medical assistant including vital signs, patient histories, EKG, x-ray, spirometry, phlebotomy, and care coordination
- Direct patient care experience
- Work alongside primary and specialty care providers
